## COVID-19 Vaccine Clinics Planned May 1 at Library Center and Library Station

April 21, 2021 — The Springfield-Greene County Health Department will host a free, public COVID-19 vaccine clinic on Saturday, May 1 at two Springfield-Greene County Libraries:

- 9 a.m.-noon at the Library Center, 4653 S. Campbell Ave. RED CU bus route
- 1-4 p.m. at the Library Station, 2535 N. Kansas Expressway. LIME CU bus route

The Pfizer vaccine will be available. The recommended interval between doses is 21 days. Participants can get their first or second shot at this clinic.

### **How to register**

Walk-ins are welcome, but registration is strongly encouraged.

All Missourians 16 years and older can register in advance and schedule a COVID-19 vaccine appointment directly through Missouri's Vaccine Navigator program. Go to [covidvaccine.mo.gov/navigator](https://covidvaccine.mo.gov/navigator).
