I would like to introduce you to Horses of Hope- Missouri, Inc (HOH). Our organization has been successfully serving the four-state area for over 25 years, starting with its original location in Baxter Springs, KS, then branching out to Buffalo, MO, and now the newest location – The HOPE Ranch in Miami, OK. We are PATH Int'l (Professional Association of Therapeutic Horsemanship) Premeire Accredited Centers. This certification upholds our facilities to the highest of standards for equine assisted programming, administration and specifically designed equine facilities.

We are excited to announce our newest location at 3555 S. FM 253 in Rogersville, Missouri. After serving Dallas County communities for nearly 17 years, HOH made the decision to move it's services from Buffalo to Rogersville to provide much needed Equine Assisted Activities and Mental Health services to the greater Springfield area. Part of those services include Therapeutic Riding (TR) and ground-based equine facilitated mental health services for which there is a significant need for these types of program offerings in Greene County and surrounding communities.

Given our current COVID climate and challenges, this type of programming is critically needed for students, families and professional staff! We provide Equine Assisted Mental Health (EAMH) services specifically designed for equine peer group mental health therapy for schools, individuals, and staff through through trauma informed and focused training events and support. We currently provide EAMH at the HOPE Ranch which serves at-risk youth in northeast Oklahoma in collaboration with the Modoc Tribe, all with tremendous success!This programming is specifically designed and presented through a trauma-informed approach and focus.

I am reaching out to area school districts and human service agencies to inform them of one of our most successful programs – Strides to Success. This program is geared specifically for students with physical, mental, developmental, social and emotional challenges. We have implemented this program for many years at our Kansas barn and former Buffalo location, and have seen remarkable transformations in the students that have participated.

The staff at HOH offers nearly 100 years of combined professional horse knowledge and equine therapeutic experience to our programming. In addition, our staff are PATH Int'l certified therapeutic riding instructors, and Equine Specialists in Mental Health and Learning. As the Executive Director, I serve as the Licensed Professional Counselor and serve the organization by partnering horses and individuals of all ages for successful personal and mental health outcomes.

I look forward to meeting with you, and discussing how Horses of Hope can serve your school district or your human service agency. Our programs have positively impacted many students', families and all types of individual's lives. We are excited to provide this "cutting edge" opportunity for your students and participants in your agencies!

WE ARE NOW PART OF THE MO MEDICAID NETWORK!



Residents with special needs in Missouri that participate in Medicaid might be eligible for Equine Assisted Activities sessions at no cost. The first step is to call and see if you or your loved one is part of a plan that is eligible for equine therapeutic services. The next step is a case manager must be assigned if one is not already, and the referral for services at HOH must be made by the case manager. If approved, clients can ride free of charge for 10 sessions (one hour per week for ten weeks). If you have any questions regarding the process, call Shannon at 417-298-6070.




